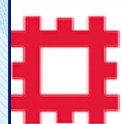
PROTECTING AND ENHANCING OUR LISTED BUILDINGS AND THE ANCIENT MONUMENT (BURY HILL CAMP)

This is our commitment to ensuring that all new developments in Thurleigh should **positively respect** our **shared heritage**. One of the key provisions of the plan will be to ensure that both the fabric and the setting of **listed buildings and heritage assets** continue to be **protected**.

A castle mound, known as **Bury Hill**, behind St. Peter's Church is scheduled as an Ancient Monument. It is thought that it was erected circa 1140 and it is possible that the church of St. Peter is built from stone originally used in the construction of the castle.

Supporting Actions:

1. To liaise with other agencies to identify local **heritage assets**.
2. To determine appropriate actions to ensure that key heritage assets are protected and enhanced.
3. To ensure that the **Ancient Monument** has an effective Monument Management Plan.
